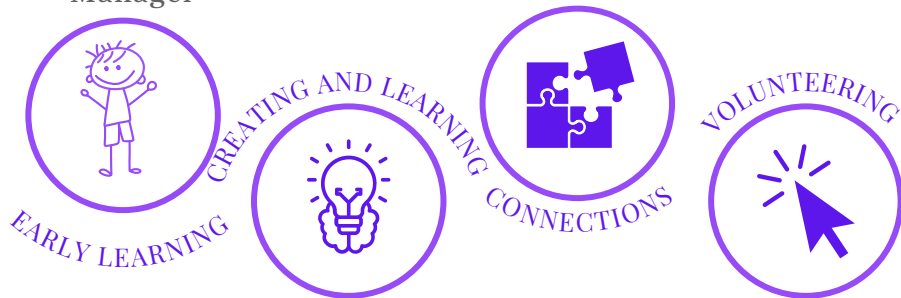
Find your way to participate at Fifteen Gibson street, perhaps in an activity to enjoy, improve your skills, socialise or to keep fit and healthy.

Talking Cafés are your opportunity to drop into a local café each week and connect with others in your community.

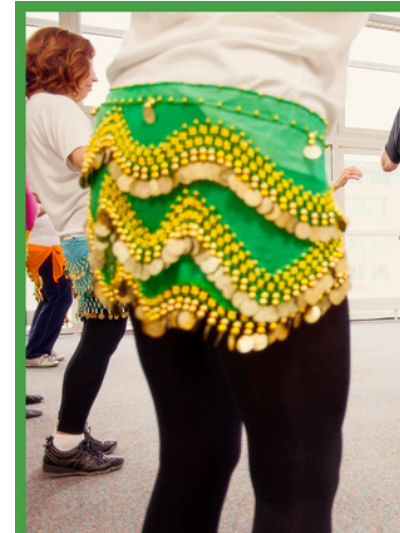

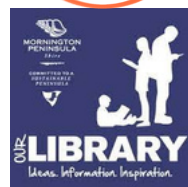

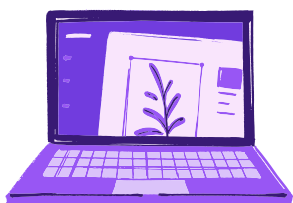

Sustainable CommUnity



We aim to balance social, economic, and environmental needs for the well-being of present and future generations. Including resource efficiency, pollution reduction, food systems, with the community invested in decision-making.

Our vegetable and fruit scraps are sent to the Dromana Community Garden at 10 Marna Street to nourish the garden.



You can drop off eligible cans and bottles for our Fundrasing to be donated to the food relief and



Dromana Food Relief volunteers rescue and save over 850 kg of food weekly. We purchase 600 kg per month from Food Bank Alex Makes Meals provide 52 meals weekly, Second Bite deliver 750 kg weekly Fareshare provide frozen meals/



We save fabric and sewing notions from landfill while promoting the use of sustainable bags made by volunteers.



We reuse 90 paper shopping bags weekly - drop yours off!

Outcomes:

We share with 158 individuals on Thursdays.
Bread/produce saved from landfill is shared in the street daily
We cook 60 three course meals at the cafe weekly
We offer Take Away Tuesday for those in need-Register please

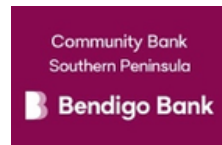
